3. Minutes of Previous Meeting (23rd October 2008):

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on 23rd October 2008 were read and agreed as a true and accurate record.

Matters Arising:

Operations Update: (Maggie)

Maggie welcomed Joe to the group and explained that he was taking over some aspects of Sarah's (Data Analyst) role.

4. Mobile Site Review:

Maggie discussed the review with Area Teams and explained what enforcement activities would be changed. Ian Windmill is visited those sites requiring

hardstandings to select an appropriate location and will be looking at other issues to try and resolve some of the parking problems.

5. **Fixed Site Review:**

Again the review was discussed resulting in enforcement modifications. The plans for digital conversions were also touched upon and Maggie informed the group that suitable sites would hopefully be selected within the next week or so.

6. **Managing Group Meeting:**

Robert briefly updated the group and spoke about the changes to funding during the next financial year.

7. **Magistrates FP Office:**

This item was discussed outside the meeting.

8. **Home Office Type Approval:**

SPECS3 have now been recommended for HO Type Approval. This should be granted during April 2009. Once HOTA has been awarded there may be discussions with Speed Check Services and Area Teams on sites recommended for time over distance camera enforcement.

9. **Any Other Business:**

Graham:

- Graham mentioned that Raynesway site was not included on the fixed review list. After the meeting it was explained that this site has now become a Cat 3 (Community concern site) due to reductions of speeds & casualties and due to the engineering activities ongoing in the area. However, the site has now been added to the list for information.
- Blue bag: Graham asked for the results. It has been decided that the bag would remain in situ and a speed survey be conducted with "tubes" for a period of time and then the bag would be removed whilst the "tubes" were still in place to assess the change in speed pattern. Results to next meeting.

Robert:

Robert spoke about the average speed camera bid for the Motorcycle Project. He explained that DfT may fund this – the kit will detect motorbikes on 8 routes (differentiates vehicle types) – there will be a link to vehicle activated signs and ANPR.
