REQUEST

1. *The gross income obtained on all roads (including motorways) through the use of speed cameras for financial periods 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09.*
2. *The net income obtained on all roads (including motorways) through the use of speed cameras for financial periods 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09.*
3. *The gross income obtained on motorways (only) through the use of speed cameras for financial periods 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09.*
4. *The net income obtained on motorways (only) through the use of speed cameras for financial periods 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09*
If net income is not available, please continue to provide details for gross income.

If gross income is not available, please continue to provide details for net income. Of course where both net income and gross income are available I expect these figures to be provided.

RESPONSE

Q1 & Q2 (2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07)

Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 requires the Casualty Reduction Enforcement Support Team, when refusing to provide such information (because the information is exempt) to provide you the applicant with a notice which:

- (a) States that fact,
- (b) Specifies the exemption in question and
- (c) States (if that would not otherwise be apparent) why the exemption applies.

In accordance with the Act, this letter represents a Refusal Notice for this particular request.

Q1 & Q2 (2007-08, 2008-09)

From 2007/08 camera activity and partnerships was integrated into wider local authority road safety activity, and expenditure on safety cameras was no longer funded through fixed penalty revenue. Central Government allocate funding to each local authority and financial information for Derby and Derbyshire Road Safety Partnership (including CREST) is therefore held by Derbyshire County Council, County Hall, Matlock, Derbyshire, DE4 3AG. However, limited financial information for the years 2007-08 and 2008-09 for the Casualty Reduction Enforcement Support Team (CREST) can also be found on our website: www.slowitdown.co.uk/Publications-&News.
