3. Minutes of Previous Meeting

PR/Marketing:

Rebecca confirmed that the summer shows have now finished. The Partnerships attendance at these shows (13 in total), was said to be well received.

DSCP representatives are to attend the International Motorcycle Show at the NEC as part of an initiative by the Midlands Regional Partnership. This campaign is particularly significant to Derbyshire due to its high proportion of speeding motorcyclists.

Rebecca also mentioned a new campaign is underway that targets the 17-24 age group. This has the slogan 'Speeding-Its not impressive', and is now on billboards around the County.

The project team are still in the process of transferring the website to another internet service provider. Rebecca is currently liaising with City for advice on finding a suitable provider for the Partnership's requirements.

OPERATIONAL CASE 2005/2006

5. Notes From Senior Partners Meeting of 8th September 2005:

Minutes from the meeting were circulated to the group.

6. Vehicle Activated Signs:

At the last meeting it was raised that a member of the public had complained about the VAS due to be erected at Tibshelf. He wants it moved away from his house, as he claims it would be too obtrusive. Roy confirmed that the situation is still pending in negotiation with Graham and the member of public. A possible compromise is that the sign may be moved slightly.

7. Rockwool - Intumescent seals to fixed housings:

Roy has tried to acquire an update from Rockwool on 9th September but is still waiting for a response.

8. WINGS System Training:

Ellen confirmed that Ben Halsteads from Systems Options came to SCP on 9th August to sort out the 2005 data. However after he left it had emerged that some data had not been transferred correctly. This has hopefully been resolved. However a check needs to be made against County's data when they have sorted theirs out.

9. Mobile Gatsos:

Lincolnshire have loaned one of their mobile Gatsos in order that Derbyshire can test the setting up and results of the system. Although they are cumbersome to manoeuvre it is felt that a test period would be useful - if successful the kit can then be fixed to a trolley type base and a lifting platform can be made within a SC mobile van.

10. Accurate Signs):

Inspector Matt Pickard previously raised the issue that he was receiving queries from the public with regard to the signing of mobile sites. Maggie asked the group if they

could all ensure that signing is accurate. Pete confirmed that all the signs in his area are now ok. Signing in other areas continues to be updated.

Action: Road Safety Teams are to report back to the Working Group on progress.

11. Hardstanding - Station Road, Mickleover:

Ellen confirmed that this has been put on hold for the time being as the 85th percentile is less than ACPO. A review and re-survey will be undertaken in the near future when September 2005 data becomes available.
