3. **Minutes of Previous Meeting:**

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on 16th January 2007 were read and agreed as a true and accurate record.

4. **Matters Arising:**

Operations Update:

PR/Marketing:

Rebecca stated that the Partnership had attended the MCN Bike Show in London. This was a great success and had the full support of Leon Haslam who attended the stand and signed a shirt which was worn by one of the members of the Partnership. The shirt is to be auctioned off by a local radio station, of which the proceeds will go to charity.

5. **DfT Guidance on Speed/Red Light Cameras – from April 2007:**

An abstract of the above document was passed around by Maggie, highlighting paragraphs 21 to 25 concerning decisions and criteria in relation to Safety Camera Site selection. Paul Robinson had asked for clarification and how to progress as of April 2007. It was agreed that this would be dealt with when the new Partnership Manager was recruited, and in post.

6. **Staff:**

Sergeant Chris Dent is currently working with the SC Unit and may transfer into the role in the next couple of months after approval has been received from Occupational Health.

7. **Speed Data Collection:**

The Police Contracts officer, Pam Gurr, has been working with the "team" to ensure that Golden River are brought to task re the slow implementation of the loops and radars. A meeting has been held earlier today.

8. **Fixed Site Assessments:**

Sarah has almost completed the assessment of the fixed sites looking particularly at casualties and speed with particular attention given to persistent high speeds. It is anticipated that the outcome of the analysis will show a need for other engineering solutions at some sites. During the next week or so all Area Teams will be emailed the result and this will be discussed in more detail to try and resolve some of the issues – a meeting with each Area Team is envisaged.

9. **Speed Awareness:**

The Chief Constable has been approached about whether the SAW be delivered "in-house", but it is believed that this will go to tender in the near future.

10. **Criteria for Site Selection of Safety Cameras:**

Confirmation of approval of the NEW drafted Site Selection criteria has been received from the attendees of the meeting held on 7th February. Senior Partners will be informed of the unanimous approval of the new draft at their meeting on 19th March.

11. **M1 motorway road widening:**

A meeting was held on 13th February at the Nottinghamshire SCP for discussions on progressing the works. The cost of the operation must be covered by the HA, with no detrimental affect to the current operations, and once a full costing process has been completed by the Partnerships the Chief Constable will be contacted for his approval before any work commences.

Keith Sharples updated the group on the current status.

12. **Any Other Business:**

- Red-light Cameras: Redspeed have asked Derbyshire to be involved in the type approval process of their new mobile cameras. This work is envisaged during the spring of this year. They have also invited the "team" to Kidderminster, their office, to view different pieces of kit. Jon Pumfrey suggested at the last meeting that two more redlight sites would be included in next year's operations so it may be useful for Jon to visit the Redspeed unit to look at alternatives to Peek. Steve Cooper and Des McGarr will survey the City sites to give a quote on costs – City and Sgt Shelley to be involved with the survey – Jon & Paul to arrange.
- Operations 2007-2011: Draft prepared for Senior Partners which was passed round and discussed.
- Ian – The hard standing on the A6 has not yet been done, it will hopefully be done in the summer along with Warwick Avenue.
- Graham – questioned if the funding would change in April, Maggie stated that as far as she was concerned for the time being it would remain the same.
- Graham – The Tibshelf and Gamesley VAS signs are now working.
