3. Minutes of previous meeting (10th June 2008)

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 10th June were read and agreed as a true and accurate record.

4. Secondary Check Markings

Jon explained that new staff are expected to be appointed in the next two weeks. Their first task will be to undertake the measuring of the secondary check markings. At present the calibrated tape measure is with Graham at County.

5. Fixed Site Review

County have been looking at existing sites to see if any can be removed or re-sited. Geoff explained that there are no monies available within the budget for such moves so the costs will need to be obtained from elsewhere. The availability of funding was to be explored before any further work in this area could be done.

6. Mobile Site Review (Sky High)

Sarah updated the group on progress with the speed surveys. Joe can convert the data from Sky High into a readable format. The surveys are almost finished.

7. National Speed Campaign

Ian explained that the national speed campaign is now underway and is for the whole of August. Officers throughout the Force are giving particular attention to speed enforcement during the month. Between 18th and 24th August a TISPOL speed campaign covers the whole of Europe.

8. The Motorcycle Show at Matlock Bath on 27th July

Sarah explained that the Show was successful for the Partnership as a whole. The unmarked van was there but, as it is unmarked, did not attract much attention from motorcyclists. In view of this, changes may be made for any future events.

9. Trial bag for Gatso/Truvelo

The bag to cover camera housings not in use fits Gatso cameras. However the Truvelo camera housings are a slightly different shape. Geoff gave an assurance to Graham that measurements would be made and given to Graham in the next few days.

10. Shuttlewood enforcement

Speed limit and camera warning signs are now in place. Mobile enforcement is being done once a month by the Safety Camera team and Roads Policing visit regularly. Speed readings are to be undertaken to check the current situation.

11. Fixed Penalty Office

Moving the Fixed Penalty Office from Ilkeston to Derby is being progressed. Alternative sites have also been considered but Derby is the only realistic option.

12. Any Other Business

Station Road, Mickleover

Jon asked if there was to be any mobile enforcement on Station Road at Mickleover. However, there is nowhere suitable to park a van. Speed surveys are to be checked for the location and a VAS is to be installed.

Truvelo camera post on A6005

The Truvelo camera post on the A6005 has been re-installed and enforcement at the site can now re-commence.
