3. Minutes of Previous Meeting (1st March 2007):

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 1st March were read and agreed as a true and accurate record.

Operations Update:

4. PR/Marketing:

Maggie informed the group that Rebecca will be leaving the SC Team to join the County team some time towards the end of the year. This will be a phased transfer over a period of 6/9 months until all this year's scheduled work has been completed. She will be sadly missed by her colleagues at Police HQ. The good work she has been involved in is significant to the education of motorists and a great credit to the work of the SC Unit.

5. Fixed Site Assessments:

Sarah has completed the assessment of the fixed sites and Maggie & Sarah have met with all Area Teams. The results will be forwarded to Senior Partners some time this week.

6. M1 motorway road widening:

Most of the M1 motorway on the stretch between junctions 25 & 28 is policed by Nottinghamshire officers. It has been provisionally agreed that Nottinghamshire SC Unit will deal with all offences, including cameras and CTO work. This has received approval from ACC Goodman, Chief Superintendent Lynn Harris, also Superintendent Kev Lea. Finder details re Magistrates and CPS potential issues will be discussed in due course.

7. **Red Speed:**

SC Officers: Paul Shelley and Pete Brothwell are to work with this company in order to test a mobile digital camera within the Home Office Type Approval process. If the test results are good we may progress these cameras as replacements for our current equipment. The LTi 20//20s are proving difficult to repair, due to being video recorders, by the end of 2007 they will be obsolete so will need to be replaced.

Jon Pumfrey is also working with the company purely to look at the red light cameras. City are looking to install a couple of sites in the Derby area in the next financial year. This will be a useful exercise as the one site already operating a red light camera does not work well and regularly requires repair – so an alternative service provider may have to be found. South Yorkshire already operate Red Speed red light cameras and a short visit to their SC Unit is being arranged within the next couple of weeks.

8. **Inaugural meeting of the new Derbyshire Road Safety Partnership – Senior Partners:**

The first meeting of the newly formed DRSP was held on Monday 30th April 2007. The Minutes of meeting and presentation slides were circulated.

9. **Any Other Business:**

- a) Data Analysis: Sarah circulated the latest casualty reduction results which showed continued reductions.
- b) Group Meetings: (Data Analyst, Speed Data, Education/Training/Publicity, Engineering/Enforcement) are in progress. Speed Data meeting have been held for the last two years and during last year progress was commenced for Data Analysis meetings – these will continue.
- c) Crown Poles (Housings): Crown have redesigned the housings, based on feedback from the Derbyshire Data Collection team. Graham is to look into their suitability for our current equipment.
