3. **Minutes of Previous Meeting (12th August 2008):**

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on 12th August were read and agreed as a true and accurate record.

Matters Arising:

Operations Update: (Maggie)

4. **Secondary Check Markings:**

Jon was asked about progress of the secondary check markings? He explained that they were held in abeyance due to staff shortages. Now that Dave Sahu had arrived work would commence. The original plan was for Jon to liaise with Moxons direct (who had undertaken similar work for County Council) and report back to the group on outcome?

5. **Mobile Site Review (Sky High):**

Maggie stated that Sarah would be analysing results of speed and casualty data and setting up a meeting with all Area Teams to discuss mobile site review within the next couple of weeks.

6. **Update from Robert on the Managing Group Meeting:**

Robert updated the group on the recent Management Group meeting, as follows:-.

- Casualty reduction updates up to August from various members were given – County appear to be doing well and City not quite so well. Motorcycle casualties in the County are down by 45%.
- County's Public service Agreement PSA2 target may be reached, it is very close.
- FOI was discussed and a more robust arrangement for Appeals is required.
- ANPR cameras – the Police & Neill Bennett (County) need to dovetail from a traffic management point of view.

7. **Trial bag for Gatso/Truvelos:**

Graham reported that the trial bag(s) should be delivered and ready for use some time this week.

8. **Magistrates FP Office:**

Move from Ilkeston to Derby was discussed. David said that there was a meeting planned on Monday 3rd November when the business case for the move would be discussed – David is to try and establish the result. It was suggested that Robert would write to HMCS to progress the move more quickly.

9. **Station Road, Mickleover:**

Speed surveys and VAS installation at this site was briefly discussed - City have this in hand. Item discharged.

10. **Child Casualties:**

Concern was raised at the rise in child casualties in the City area. Annually there are approximately 20 child casualties per annum throughout the City area. Child casualties are relatively low in numbers and any increase, no matter how small, per site, appears to be quite significant in terms of percentages at these locations. City Council are involved in a number of initiatives, Safer routes to school and pedestrian and cycle training to address child casualties.

11. **Any Other Business:**

Graham: Graham asked if the SPECS system was on any part of the Derbyshire section. The current road widening work on J24-28 is being dealt with by the Nottinghamshire Partnership to simplify the process.

Pete: Pete asked if there was any capital monies available within the budget. Robert informed the meeting that there was some capital budget still to be had.

Departmental Review (County): It was mentioned that the departmental review was underway and at the moment County Area Teams were unsure who was working where.

Community Speed Watch (Repton): The meeting were informed that the funding for this was via Safer Derbyshire Community Safety.

Robert: Robert informed the meeting that the Casualty Report was out and that copies were available for everyone.
