3. Minutes of Previous Meeting:

5. Site Selection 2003/2004:

Ellen produced the spreadsheet of all sites selected for the next financial year 2003/2004, which is to be included in the Operational Case due to be submitted to Department for Transport before 30th November 2002.

Some minor changes were recommended and are to be amended.

6. Truvelo Cameras - New Sites 2002/3:

Maggie has liaised with Peter Hill of Truvelo and he is to arrange the training of CTO staff and Data Collection Officers some time next week. The first site to go live will be Long Eaton, possibly the second week in December.

Serco have arranged to visit the housings requiring attention on 27th and 28th November. They are to return on the 3rd/4th/5th December to undertake the calibrations.

8. A5250 Burton Road Derby:

This site continues to cause problems in relation to ownership, which is proving frustrating. Jon is to try and progress.

9. **Any Other Business:**

❖ Mobile Operation

PC Paul Shelley has suggested one of the Mobile Operators attend the next Working Group meeting to demonstrate the equipment. The Partners can then discuss any queries on the mobile operation. Maggie is to arrange for the officer/vehicle to attend the next meeting. It was also felt that a Data Collection Officer should be asked to attend for the same purpose. This will be arranged as soon as possible. A site visit to the Gatso and Truvelo sites is to be arranged in the New Year.

❖ Hi-Stars – speed data collection:

Paul Robinson asked if the group could be updated on the perceived problem with Hi-Star equipment, identified by the British Motorcycle Federation. Paul has been contacted by other Partnerships on similar matters. At the moment there are no reported incidents to any of the known Partnerships using the equipment.

Maggie is to meet with Highway Care (Steve Powell) and Sergeant Paul Hawkins soon after a meeting has been held with the manufacturers, and will report back to the Partners on the result.

❖ Gatso/Truvelo – site selection:

Geoff Hall asked if a decision had been made as to what cameras we were to use for the 2003/2004 sites. It was decided that until the Truvelo's had been "tested" during the early part of 2003, a decision would not be made.

❖ Gerry Goodman – Truvelo works:

A program of Truvelo works starts on 2nd December for the A6 Buxton. The signs are to be changed from mobile to fixed routes.

Philip Bellefontaine asked Gerry if he would consult the Derbyshire County Council members on the progress.
